“Why Doesn’t God Do Something?”

The question is often asked, “why doesn’t God do something about the condition of the world? Why does He put up with the evil about us?”

The answer to these questions is God IS doing something.

Christ states emphatically, “My Father worketh hitherto, and I work.” Clearly God is working still! He has been working all along.

What has He done? For one thing, He has sent Christ. The cross is a fact of history and the resurrection an unmistakable assurance of His triumph over evil. Christ insists, “I am working.”

Through every life surrendered to Him, God keeps on working. He worked through William Knibb and Abraham Lincoln to undo slavery, through Florence Nightingale and Louis Pasteur to relieve suffering, through William Carey and Adoniram Judson to bring salvation to lands where Christ was not known.

We may not recognize it, but He is working now. Sometimes His movements are with the swiftness of light, but more often they are like the wind which Christ said, “Bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth.”

A more appropriate question than, “Is God doing anything?” would be, “Are we letting Him do through us what He longs to do to correct evil and to bring salvation to men?” If He is waiting at all, He is waiting for our response. – Gilbert L. Guffin (reproduced from a May 1952 bulletin)
